Places where you can dine outdoors with your dog...

Belfast

Wasses Hot Dogs (Reny's Parking Lot, Rt. 3)
Young's Seafood (turn right off Rt 1 just .5 miles north of the harbor bridge)
Food trucks located at Bank of America off Rt. 52 or Rt. 3 or at Goose River Butcher Shop (smoker outside) or behind Rollies in downtown Belfast.

Northport

Bayside General Store (Rt. 1)

Lincolnton

McLaughlin's Shack (Rt 173 intersection at Lincolnton Beach)
Chez Michel (Rt 1 at Lincolnton Beach) – picnic table

Camden

Scott's (Reny's Shopping Center off Elm)
Mt. Battie Take Out by Camden Hills State Park entrance
Harbor Dog (waterfront parking lot at Camden Harbor)

Rockport

The Helm (Rt 1 south of Camden) has picnic tables and take-out window
Graffam Brothers Seafood Shack on Union has picnic tables

Rockland

The Claw – Rt. 1 .5 miles after McDonalds on left
Seafood Shack by Children's Museum
At Harbor Park – Food trucks daily (on Thursday the Rockland Farmer's Market – Uproot Pie Co.)
Wasses Hot Dogs and several other outside food stands (see the Ferry Terminal Parking Lot, the Warf Parking Lot, and others – there are food trucks allowed in Rockland).

Thomaston

Slipway (on the wharf in Thomaston – you will see signs along Rt 1 to turn left)

Port Clyde

DipNet (on the wharf at Port Clyde next to the Port Clyde General Store)
Port Clyde General Store
Note – on the way to Port Clyde there will be several road-side options as well.

Support Local Dog-friendly Businesses!

The Loyal Biscuit Company (with shops in Reny's Plaza Belfast, Camden, and Rockland) – offers use of their pet-wash station for FREE! (Be sure to take this info sheet with you!)

The Maine Dog (shop in Camden on Bayview St.)

Schooner Olad – enjoy a sail on Penobscot Bay and take your dog along (at no extra charge). See brochure with discount coupon! Dogs must be leashed and please take along snacks/water for your pet.

Camden Hills State Park turn south from Bay Leaf Cottages – go about 3-4 miles – will be on your right.

Monhegan Boat Line out of Port Clyde (wonderful nature cruises and ferry service to Monhegan Island) - Nature and art lovers from all over come to experience this wonderfully scenic island that provides about 17 miles of trails to explore it plus a number of shops and artists' studios. This ferry will transport dogs to the island for an additional pet fee of \$5 per dog. Dogs must be well mannered, under their owner's control, leashed, and cleaned up after at all times. See brochure in your room or our library in the main house.

Maine State Ferry Service – Ferry from Lincolnville Beach to Islesboro Island – see Grindle Point Lighthouse, stop by the Community Center for Chowder, and enjoy books at Artisan Books. View the elegant homes and mansions throughout the island. Maybe you'll even see some of the more famous residents (John Travolta, Tim Hutton, John Fairbanks, or Kirstie Alley). Or, from Rockland to Vinalhaven Island for a day-trip to see the artisans and shops. Dogs must be well behaved, under their owner's immediate control, securely leashed, crated, or caged and cleaned up after at all times. No dog fee.

Water Walker Sea Kayaks – 152 Lincolnville Ave, Belfast. This water adventure company offers custom tours, instruction, and kayak rentals. Dogs are allowed on rentals for no additional fee. Dogs must be friendly, under their owner's control at all times, and leashed.

Belfast Dog Park – Lincolnville Ave, Belfast (go north from our property to the first traffic light, turn left and it will be on the left). Located at Walsh Field, this spacious fenced off leash area offers a motion-activated dog waterer, a variety of structures, and benches. A maintenance day is held the 2nd Saturday of each month from 9am to 11am. The park remains open during the maintenance work, and dogs and owners are welcome to enjoy the park during this time.. Dogs must be sociable, current on all vaccinations and license, and under their owner's control at all times. Dogs must be leashed when not in designated off-lead areas.
